Minutes of the Meeting

Welcome and Apologies

The Chair welcomed everyone to the meeting. Apologies were received from Kate Jones, Lily Clarke, Susannah Gooch, Esme Freedman, Tom Meadley, Jess Fisher, Ryan Pilkington, Ruth Allen, Jamie Arthur and Lee Beldam.

A special welcome was given to Alicia Langton-Balchin who has joined SDYC for the first time, representing Maidenhill School. Members introduced themselves.

Kieran congratulated Steve on being nominated for the Heart of Gloucestershire Community Awards in the Public Sector category. He was nominated by Annie Pickering, SDYC ex-offcio member for his 100% commitment.

Kieran explained that the 'business' part of the meeting would take place until 5.30pm and would then be followed by a tour of the Subscription rooms and a workshop on how the venue could attract / involve young people more, in the future.

Minutes of Last Meeting, 29th April 2013

Kieran went through minutes of the previous meeting; they were agreed to be a true and accurate record.

Matters Arising

a) Cotswold Canal Trust meeting on 9th April postponed; new date to be confirmed

The Cotswold Canal Trust meeting was postponed on 9th April; a new date is to be arranged shortly.

Kieran added that 2 weeks ago he had the opportunity, along with Steve and other officers of Stroud District Council, to walk along the bottom of the new canal section near Waitrose in Stroud - it's due to be filled over the summer.

b) Youth Unemployment: Review of Training for Young People with Low Qualifications – confirm feedback to LSP (All)

The document (as requested) was circulated to all members of the group and it was around 30 - 40 pages long and was a comprehensive document. The LSP (Local Strategic Partnership) meeting is scheduled for Friday 7th June 2013 and it would be worthwhile to provide feedback on the document to them from a young person's perspective.

c) SDYC Consultation on Work Experience – Next Steps (Millie)

At the previous meeting a questionnaire was completed from members who were present; this has now been compiled and put into a presentation which will be made to the LSP at their next meeting. This is only the start of a huge piece of work that Millie is leading on with support of the new project team.

Employment and Training Working Group members; Millie, Kirsty, Charlotte, Susannah and Emily will meet soon to plan how this consultation will be rolled out across the district. Suggestions include visiting local youth forums, groups, colleges, schools, etc as well as setting up a 'survey monkey' type link as a more accessible way to collate information.

d) Young Driver Experience at Castle Combe – Update (Steve)

Steve highlighted that all 12 spaces on the Young Driver Experience Course have now been taken; Steve will forward additional information to individuals ahead of 29th May. He added that there could be potential to carry out some focused group work on 'road safety' in the future.

British Youth Council

South West Youth Voice Convention

There is an event being held on Wednesday 29th May 2013 at the Albermarle Centre, Taunton. Aimed at involving representatives from a variety of youth councils, young mayors and youth parliament members, the event is hosted by the British Youth Council and UK Youth Parliament. Whilst this event clashes with the Young Drivers Experience, other members interested in going were encouraged to let Steve know ASAP.

Positive Tickets- Police and Neighbourhood Warden

A 'Positive Ticket' scheme is currently operating in Canada and has proved very successful; in essence children and young people are acknowledged for positive behaviour by the Police with the aim being to engage local Police with children and young people in a positive manner. Tickets are issued for a number of reasons e.g. riding a bike with lights on at night, being seen to put rubbish in the bin, demonstrating good manners in a public place, scooting or skate-boarding in a considerate manner.

Local Police and Neighbourhood Wardens are currently looking into the idea of a similar system for the Stroud district; they are also in discussion with sports development officers about the potential to 'cash in' these positive tickets for leisure and sporting activities. They would like to attend a meeting to talk to members of SDYC about the thoughts and opinions of this scheme. Steve will arrange this for the near future.
