SDYC02/03.31 MINUTES OF THE LAST MEETING

SDYC02/03.32 MEMBERS' MAIL

Katy Costigan reported that Dan Flack had not received his minutes/agenda for the past two meetings. Dave Marshall undertook to investigate.

SDYC02/03.33 GERMAN VISITORS

Barbara Tait introduced four German visitors to the meeting - all four were gaining work experience in Stonehouse. The Chairman welcomed them on behalf of the Youth Council.

SDYC02/03.34 BUDGET 2004/5

Clive Hammond described the work of Stroud District Council's Accountancy & Audit Team. He reported that he had held a meeting with Lisa Hogg, the Youth Council's

Cabinet Member for Resources. As a result, all members had received a copy of SDC's budget survey, which everyone was asked to complete. The results would then be compared with SDC's own telephone survey, to establish whether young people had different views.

Barbara Tait added that the Administration would take the views of the Youth Council very seriously when putting together next year's budget.

SDYC02/03.35 TALENTED PERFORMER GRANT AID PROGRAMME

Sophie reported on her further discussions with Jane Bullows and the request for the Youth Council to earmark £2000 for sports grants to talented individuals. Dave Marshall advised that he had been in discussion with Nigel Studdert-Kennedy. As a result, it was proposed that the £2000 should be set aside immediately. Next year's "set aside" would be dependent on £2000 being added to the Youth Council budget.

The process would be that Jane would draw up the application paperwork. Applications would be passed to Sophie, who would make a recommendation to the full Youth Council.

Kylie Gibbon reported on her meeting with Nico and Katy. As a result, three possible designs of website were shown to members; the first was chosen. Kylie will now put the site together and report to members before it goes live.
