2 Minutes:

3 Feedback from Away Weekend:

5 Youth Council website:

Juzer presented his work on a Youth Council website. Members agreed that they would hold an extra meeting at **4:30pm on Monday**, **9**th **December** in order to progress this project (*Note - this will take place in the Committee Room - just beyond the Council Chamber. A PC will be available.*)

6 Funding Requests:

Two funding requests from Minchinhampton Youth Club were presented by Debbie Lang:-

a). £400 was requested for materials and an artist's time to enable members to paint a mural in the disco room. This was agreed.

b). £400 was requested to fund a promotional video making the case for a skate park at the Youth Club. Members invited a member of the Club to a future meeting in order to explain the request in more detail.

7 Wotton under Edge Cinema:

Sophie updated members on Wotton cinema. A group, mainly of parents, had been set up to refurbish the building, which would probably have uses other than as a cinema. The downside of this was that it may well be difficult to buy in blockbuster films. At present, there was nothing the Youth Council could do, especially in the light of the large sums of money being sought. Dave Marshall pointed out that support from the Youth Council could be very important in future, and that there was no reason why a small grant could not be given, particularly as a gesture of support.

Nigel Studdert-Kennedy mentioned that an application had been made to Stroud District Council for a large Rural Project Grant, but that it did not fall within the criteria of "Rural". Sophie undertook to keep the Youth Council informed.

8 Young People's Themed Grants:

Dave Marshall circulated a draft copy of Stroud District Council's proposed grants for Young People's Projects in 2003/4. It was emphasised that the list was confidential and for members' eyes only. He explained that every year, the Council gives grants on a particular theme - eg the elderly, disabled, young people etc. Anyone with any question or comment was asked to email or contact Dave as soon as possible (david.marshall@stroud.gov.uk).

9 Connexions:

Lisa reported that Connexions were interested in the Youth Council and would like to attend a meeting. It was agreed that they could be invited to attend either the 16th December meeting, or 6th January.

10 Any other business:

Dave advised members that the Conservative Group had agreed to hand over their meeting room for use by the Youth Council. Stroud District Council would also supply access cards so that Youth Councillors could meet in the room at any time. A PC (and hopefully a laptop) would also be provided.
