6. Updates from School & College Councils and Local Youth Forum Groups

Archway School – No student council meeting – successful walk-out left school regarding climate change 150-180 students. Year 12 work experience

Berkeley Vale YF – Tails of Old Berkeley Event was successful. Intergenerational project with Jenner Court residents during Easter break is being planned.

Cainscross YF - Litter Pick/ fundraisers in Easter break.

Cam & Dursley YF – Presenting to Cam Parish Council and Dursley Town Council next week to promote C-Card via music event. Speed check being planned.

Hardwicke Youth Forum – Developing group logo and progressing the work on the local consultation survey.

Marling School – Still no school council meetings. One expected next week. Climate Change protest – 100 young people were stopped from attending by teaching staff. Head boy spoken to regarding student council and he's stated that he will get it sorted.

Nailsworth & Minchinhampton YF – Community survey on Forest Green.

Stroud High School – Students stopped from support climate change protest.

Stroud Town & Five Valleys YF – Toured town and five valleys with Neighborhood warden. Met with Town Council again to tour and discussed local facilities for young people.

Stonehouse Action 4 Youth – Organising health fitness project to enable young people to be more active.

7. Youth Parliament Update- Hanna Doherty, MYP for Stroud & Cotswold

Hanna was welcomed to the meeting. Hanna explained her role and what it does. She highlighted that she was looking to build better links with SDYC members and those of the youth parliament. The national campaigns are: Votes at 16 and also Knife Crime. It was felt there was an opportunity to link the latter to more local social issues, like county lines and mental health. She referred to advice of surveying schools regarding mental health. Hanna also wants to improve relationship with Stroud, if elected to serve for a further two years in the forthcoming elections - deadline for voting this Sunday.

a) Anti- Bullying Project Team – 23 January & 6 February 2019

Youth Survey

To propose that SDYC approve the draft survey to be sent out to schools and community groups – questions were raised by members.

Gathering information

To note that the project team is continuing to gather information from young people about how they feel about bullying and the way it is dealt with in schools. To propose that the group begin to research and put together materials to go into a support park for victims of bullying.

Creating an Anti-Bullying Policy

To note that the team are looking forwards to creating their own policy, which will be created from the results from the survey, and from schools policies.

b) Health Focus Group - 28 January & 11 February 2019

Sexual Health Services

Decision to propose that SDYC take on the C-Card secret shopper and C-Card champion's project. Offering it out to all members and the youth forum. The youth forums maybe better placed to do these roles in the communities. Over 13 members are interested in gaining more information. Sexual Health Promotion has stopped over last 8 years. An explanation of what a secret shopper is and does, was given.

Public Health School Nursing national consultation through the BYC

Decision to recommend youth council members complete the survey.

Youth friendly GP surgeries

SDYC members to give feedback on the criteria done so far.
