YOUTH CABINET REPORT

A Youth Cabinet meeting did not take place due to low numbers however 3 Youth Initiative Fund Applications were discussed in the council meeting. Although a quorum was not present it was agreed with whom present that the members in attendance would make the decision on whether the applications should get the funding they requested. The applications discussed were as follows:

- Mike Haddock, Stroud Rural Youth Project requesting £1500 to go towards an ICT suite with Broadband Internet Access.
- Tracy Young, Nailsworth Youth Club requesting £500 to go towards 2 weeks of activities and trips.
- Steve Miles & Meg Brown, Wotton Youth Centre requesting £750 to go towards a summer holiday activity programme.

Members at the meeting agreed to grant all 3 applications the full amount of funding.
