Hear by Right

A team of four 2006/2007 district youth councillors, Alex Jones, Emma Mears, Natalie Smith and Rose Horton presented the national Hear by Right standards concept created and developed by the National Youth Agency for the active involvement of children and young people. They used an interactive activity to explain how the seven standards worked and how it benefits young people. It was highlighted that the mapping and planning process to this concept will be carried out on 16 November as a one day event involving youth councillors from SDYC, senior officers, heads of service and elected members of SDC.
